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NATO-UKRAINE DEFENSE AND SECURITY COOPERATION

The NATO-Ukraine Joint Military Reform Group (AWG) is a working body of the NATO-Ukraine Commission (NATO) to maintain a military and political dialogue and ensure practical cooperation between Ukraine and the Alliance in the field of security and defense.

The main goal of Ukraine is to adapt the national defense planning system to the norms and procedures adopted in the Alliance. NATO's standardization system covers all areas of defense activities, from military management procedures to logistics, technical requirements, development, production, maintenance, repair and modernization, disposal. NATO standards are implemented in Ukraine in accordance with the Defense Ministry's guidance documents and the Roadmap for Cooperation with the NATO Standardization Agency.
